



FAQ eLearning

1. Do I need to download worksheets from the eLearning?

It is recommended that you do, this will assist you in your learning pathway. If you are considering to apply for one of the nationally recognised Certificates - you will need to use your completed worksheets as part of your portfolio of evidence.

2. I finished my leader training before eLearning was introduced, do I need to complete any eLearning Modules?

If you are continuing in your current leadership role then generally no. However it is expected that leaders do some training every year and completing an eLearning Module each year is a good way to continue to improve your skills and knowledge. There are many Elective eLearning Modules that are informative and interesting.

3. Can I run a group eLearning session?

Group Training using e-learning modules will only be allowed in the following circumstances.

- a. Modules previously not undertaken or completed by an individual can only be undertaken on a group basis when the session is been led by an ALT or LT and the following procedures must be followed;
 - i. The proposed session must be authorised by the SCATD in advance.
 - ii. The session presenter (ALT, LT) must complete a Course Report Form (paper based) including the details of all participants, the module/s presented and any assistants used in presenting the session. This completed form is then forwarded to the Training Officer at Victorian Scout Service Centre, 152 Forster Rd, Mt Waverley, for recording of the e-learning module against the learners' personal training record.
- b. Leaders who are participating in a group based module presentation as part of a District/Region meeting will not have the individual module recorded on their record, but instead will have it noted that they participated in a "Professional Development" session. These sessions can be conducted by a suitably qualified presenter not necessarily a trainer.
