Information about your Visit to West Heidelberg's Elsedeaq Mosque, Sunday, August 26, 2018, 2.45 (sharp) – 4.15 pm

[Location: Elsedeaq Mosque, corner of Lloyd & Elliott Streets, West Heidelberg: Melway Map 31 G1]

Your guide when attending a mosque is to be modest in dress, ie, conservative clothes with only simple or no makeup or jewellery. See additional information, below.

Uniform is **not** required. Only wear Scout Uniform if it fits within the dress code.

Shoes

- <u>Casual</u> shoes (*not* high heels) that are easy to take off before going into the prayer hall
- Socks or stockings to wear when walking without shoes (it's cold in August!)

<u>Men – Shirt with half or long sleeves</u>

- Scout, casual or dress shirt with <u>half</u> or <u>long sleeves</u> is appropriate
- Scout, casual or dress trousers are appropriate
- Please, no T-shirts

Women - Cover arms, legs, midriff

- Long sleeve, loose-fitting shirts, blouses and jackets are appropriate
- Full-length, loose-fitting trousers, jeans, slacks or long skirts are appropriate
- Please, no T-shirts, tight-fitting, short sleeve or sleeveless blouses/tops
- Please, <u>no</u> partial tops or low-fitting trousers/jeans that show midriff (belly) when standing or when sitting on a chair or the floor

Women - Cover hair during prayers

- For women please bring a head <u>scarf</u> that you can wear during afternoon prayers in the prayer hall
- No need to cover your hair when your first arrive

A simple triangular scarf that can be tied at the back of your neck or under your chin is suitable to wear in the prayer hall. If you have a <u>spare scarf</u>, <u>please</u> bring it with you, just in case someone else needs to borrow it.
