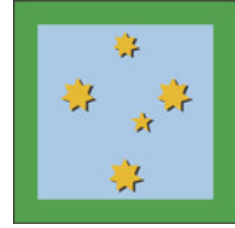


# Citizenship

## 3. Cub Scout Code of Living

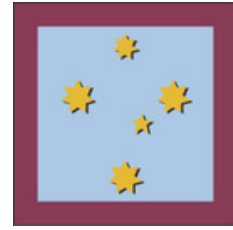
- a. List four ways or things that you consider people should do to be a good citizen.
