The Unit Management Course is designed to:

- assist Unit Council members to run more effective Unit Council meetings.
- enable Venturers to take a more effective role in supporting the running of the Venturer Unit.

This is a course which has active involvement and participation for Venturers and Leaders.

A key aspect is involvement from Unit Leaders who we need to assist throughout the course. It is also an excellent opportunity for new (and not so new) Venturer Leaders to build their knowledge about how the Unit should operate.

This course is open to all invested Venturer Scouts whether members of the Unit Council or not (there is no age restriction).

This course is part of the award scheme requirements for the Venturer Award and Queen's Scout Award.

Tips: registering, confirming and paying for the course

1. To register, you will be asked for your email. It is likely that the email address stored in the system is not the Venturer's email address, but the parents. If you have any difficulty registering, or the online registration system says; You are not eligible, or We cannot verify your information, do not hesitate to ring 85439829 for assistance and your current email address can be added to the system so you can register.
2. The current payment system is that the invoice for the course is added to the Workflow for your Group Leader. It is recommended that you ask the Group Leader to forward the invoice to you, and then payment options are listed on the invoice. To pay by credit card, you won't be able to access the Extranet but instead can call the State Training Office (see contact info above)
3. Once you have registered for the course, an email will automatically be sent to the email address. You must click on the link in the email to CONFIRM you are attending the course, to complete your registration.
