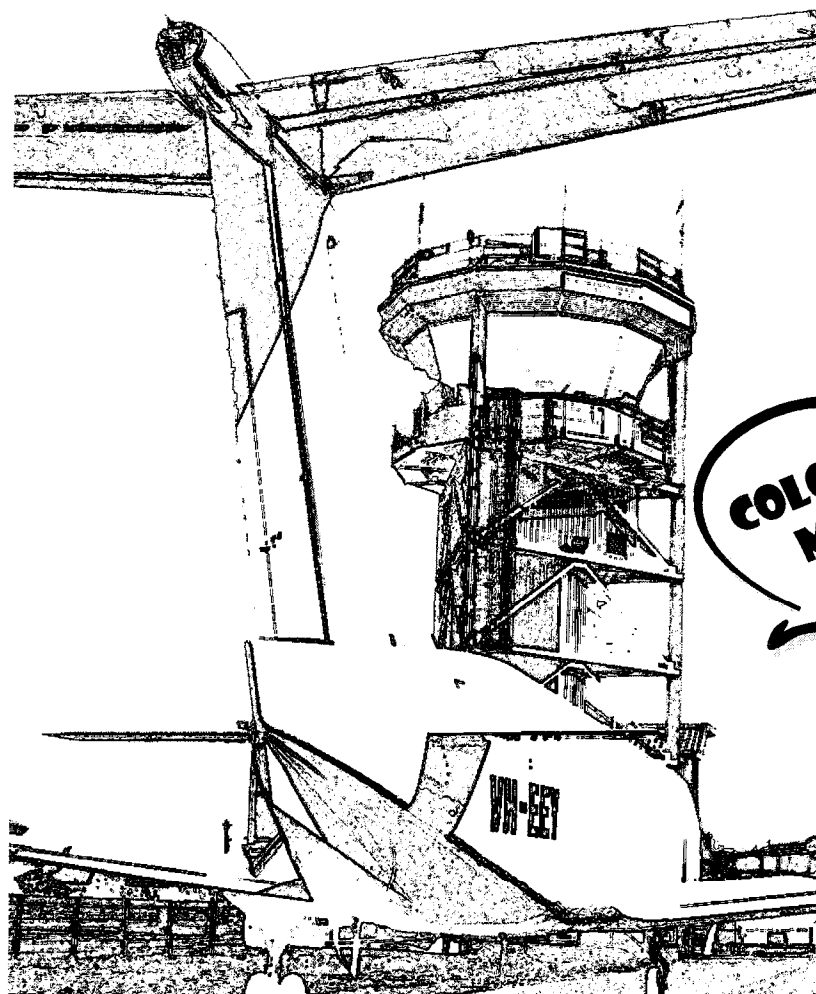

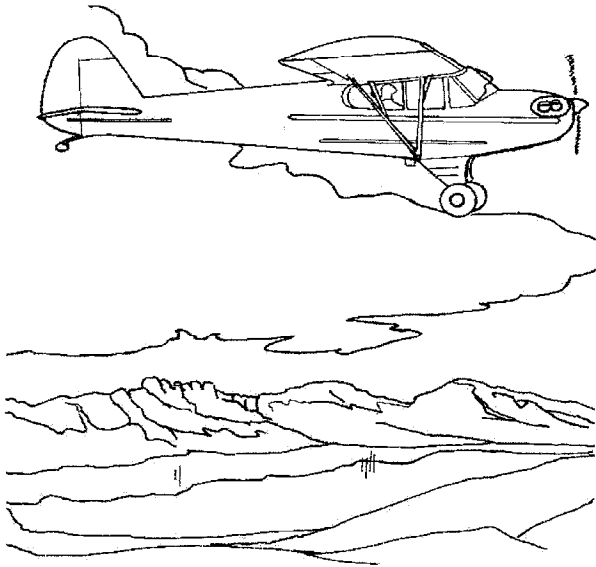
# HIGH FLIGHT

This poem does!!

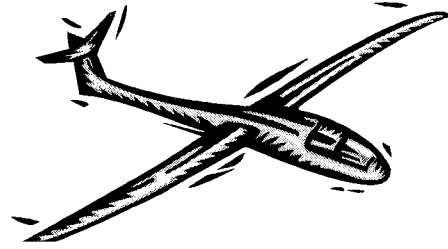
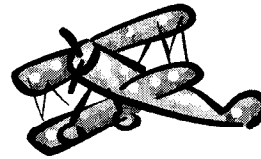
Oh! I have slipped the surly bonds of Earth

put out my hand, and touched the face of God.

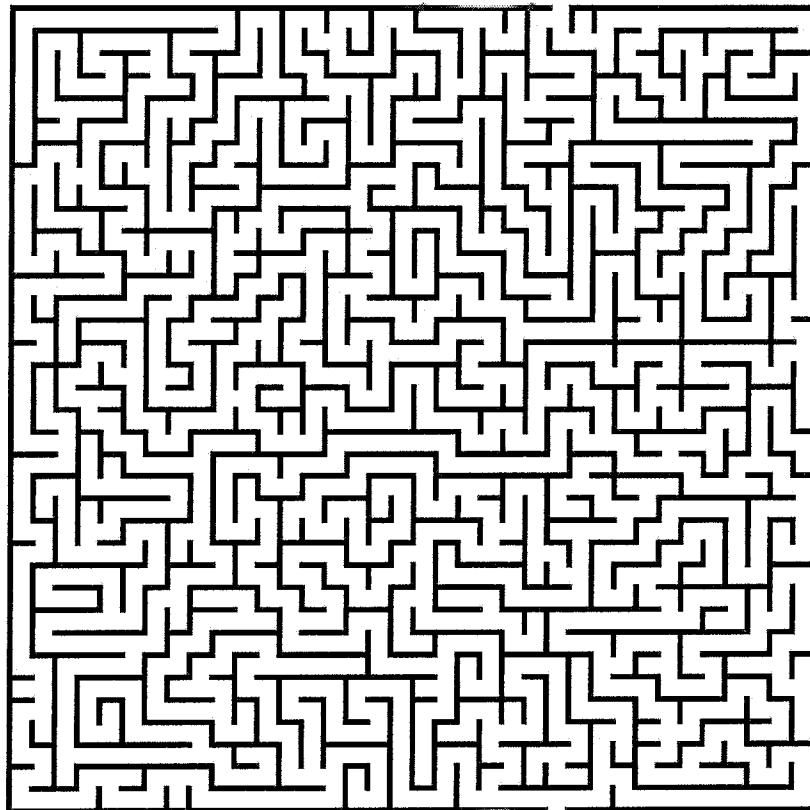

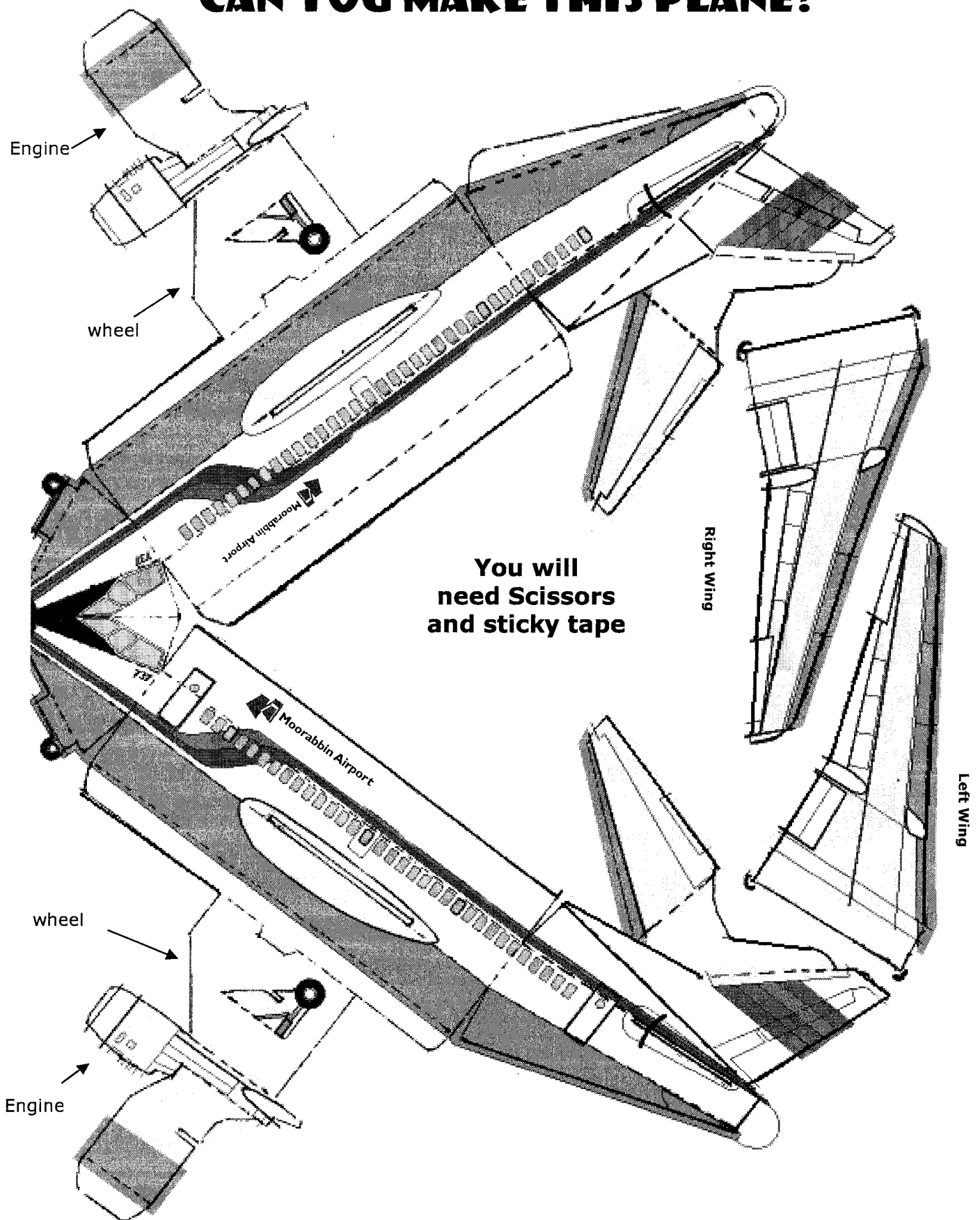


# **TAXI SIR? TAKE A BUSINESS JET TO BRISBANE**

in Australia from Moorabbin**

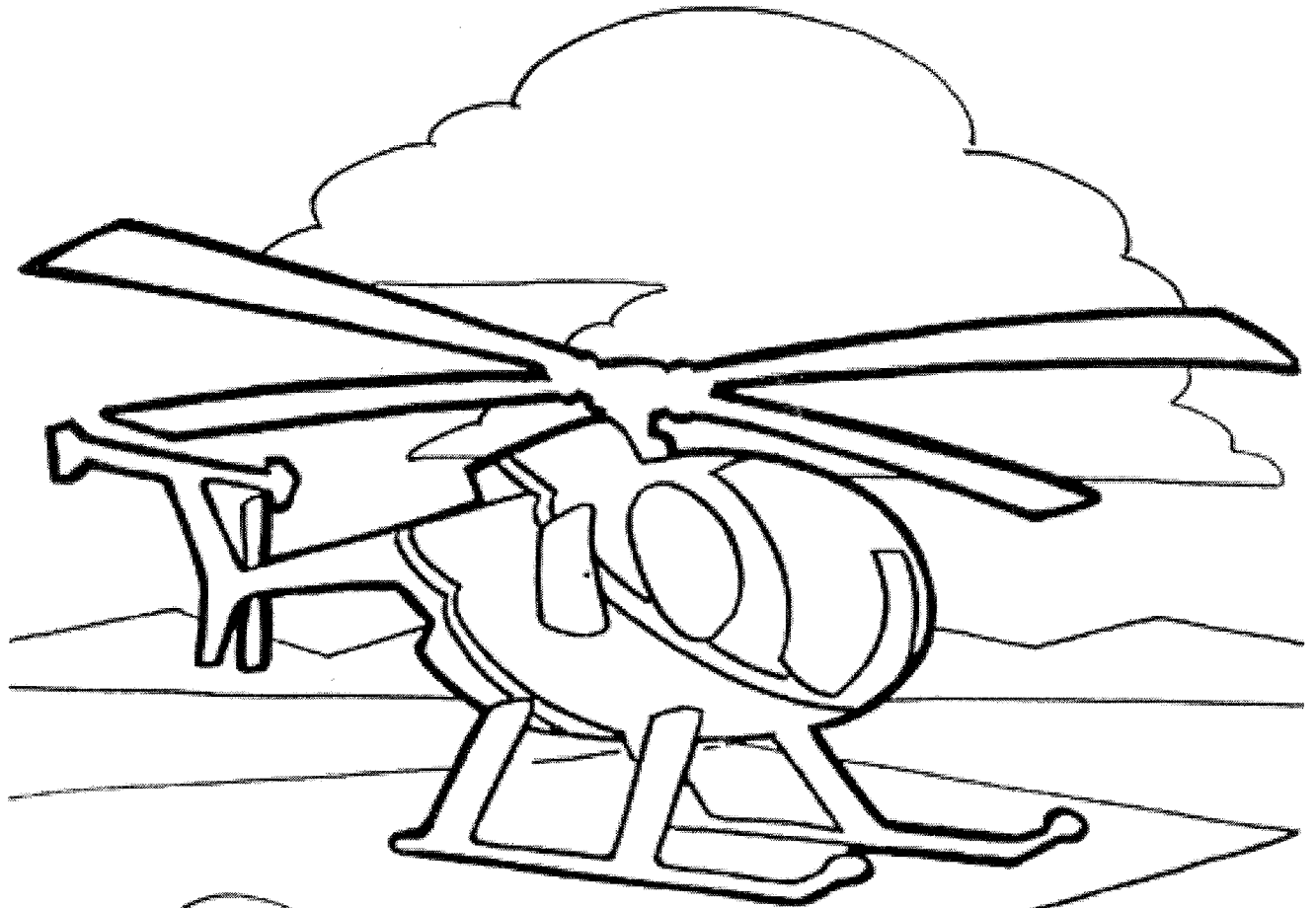
# CAN YOU MAKE THIS PLANE?


