



Cuboree X – 2020 Photo Guide

It is important that you submit an accurate and clear Photo for Cuboree. This photo is for identification purposes and may need to be used in a safety or medical situation.

There are some specific criteria that this photo must meet. The requirements are listed below:

Your Photo Must:

- ✓ Be a good quality image of you taken in full colour
- ✓ Have a plain, light-coloured background (e.g. cream, pale blue or white)
- ✓ Have uniform lighting (no shadows across or behind your face), sharp focus and must be clear
- ✓ Be less than 18 months old at the start of Cuboree 2020 (so please use a recent photo when you submit your application)

Your Photo Must Show:

- ✓ Your head and top of your shoulders close up
- ✓ Your shoulders square on (not looking over shoulder)
- ✓ Your face square on (edges of your face should be visible)
- ✓ You looking straight at the camera (not tilted head)
- ✓ You with a neutral expression and your mouth closed (not laughing or frowning)
- ✓ Your eyes open and clearly visible, (no hair in eyes)

Head coverings:

The photograph must show you without any hat or other head covering unless you wear a head covering for religious reasons. In this case, it's quite OK to wear the head covering in your photo. As this image may be used for identification, we do ask that your facial features from the bottom of your chin to the top of your forehead and both edges of your face be clearly shown. If you submit a photo that doesn't meet the requirements outlined above, you will receive an e-mail letting you know that you need to submit another one. If you have put in an online application, simply log back into the application system using your user name and password and upload the new photo in the same way you did the original. Your old photo will be overwritten with your new one.
