Making a wreath

Make a wreath to hang on your letterbox this Anzac Day.

You will need

- Egg carton
- Paper plate
- Paint or textas (red, green & black)
- Paint Brush (optional)
- 30cm string
- Sticky tape
- Scissors
- Glue

Instructions

- 1** Draw a circle and cut out middle of paper plate
- 2** Cut individual cups out of the egg carton and paint or colour red. Let dry then paint the middle black.
- 3** Paint or colour outside of plate black.
- 4** Once dry glue the flowers to the edge of the plate.
- 5** Turn plate over and sticky tape string to top.
- 6** Get circle that was cut out from middle of plate and cut out strip. Write your message on strip and decorate if you wish. Then tape strip to back of plate.
- 7** Why not use the scraps from your egg carton to create some leaves for your wreath you can paint or colour them and glue them between flowers.
