  - Opening for applications date not before late January 2021

  - Viccon with Scout Commissioners form Units Sunday May 9
  - Units fine tuned over next month

#### Project Patrols

• Unit Patrols for the Expedition, this being based upon the preferences for which expedition the Scouts have selected. JPLs & AJPLs also to be appointed.



### Design your own Jamboree experience

- Jamboree Patrols will plan their own adventure.
- As part of their Plan> stage, each Patrol will be able to read the list of activities and design their Jamboree experience as a Patrol.
- 3 x day activities, 1 x overnight activity (expedition in Project Patrol), 7 x onsite bases, 1.5 x duty patrol.
- JPLs and AJPLs will be responsible for adding preferences for Patrol.
- Activities in the online system 2-3 months before the Jamboree.
- Leaders will have access to assist their youth as needed.



#### Unit Council

- Units are being formed early to allow for time to Plan>.
- A number of Patrol and Unit Councils should be able to be held pre Jamboree.
- Selection of Jamboree Unit Leader JUL (one of the JPLs) by the youth.
- Jamboree Unit Leader JUL
  - JUL member of the Unit leadership team advocate for youth and will communicate with Viccon youth members.
  - JUL will participate & represent Unit at pre Jamboree events (JUL orientation day September 25 2021.
  - JUL will assist the Line Leaders planning a Unit based approach to AJ2022.

- Jamboree Patrol Leaders
  - Leadership role for the Patrol.
  - Lead planning for the Patrol and ensure that all Scouts in the Patrol are catered for.
  - Supported by JUL and Line Leaders.
- JSL and Line Leaders (excluding carers)
  - Support JUL and JPLs in Plan>Do>Review> for AJ2022.
  - Viccon has prepared an initial resource book to assist adult leaders in understanding the detail of the roles and what is involved.



- Gear drop & collect no youth, parent support
  - Because we are in Victoria Units can deliver their gear to site.
  - Gear will need to be secured from the elements
  - No trailers or vehicles can be left onsite
  - Drop off December 11 and 12 2021
  - Collection January 15 and 16 2022 (Straight after AJ2022 finishes)
  - Site will be a "Worksafe Site" so NO youth (under 18 yo) allowed on site
  - Recommended that parents are "Voluntold" that gear drop off & collection is something that they can do to support the Unit going to AJ2022.
