



## Milestones – Participate, Assist & Lead

In the Scout Section, participate, assist and lead for the Milestones looks like this:

<b>Participate</b>	Attendance and involvement in the activities of the Unit.	Active participation in a Challenge Area-related activity reviewing your learning.	Active participation in a Challenge Area-related activity reviewing your learning.
<b>Assist</b>	Assist in planning, doing and reviewing an activity.	Assisting in the organisation of a Challenge Area-related event, including delivery of at least one activity.	Assisting in the organisation of a Challenge Area-related event, including delivery of at least one activity.
<b>Lead</b>	Lead an activity and take a leading role in planning and reviewing it.	Organising the program for a Challenge Area-related event (eg a Unit night or camp) and leading the running of it, including arranging multiple activities. This may also include acting as a Project Patrol Leader for a Challenge Area-based project.	Organising the program for a Challenge Area-related event (eg a Unit night or camp) and leading the running of it, including arranging multiple activities. This may also include acting as a Project Patrol Leader for a Challenge Area-based project.

To achieve a particular Milestone, a Scout will need to complete a number of participates, assists and leads as follows:

<b>Milestone 1</b>	Participate in 6 activities from each Challenge Area	Assist in 2 or more activities across two or more Challenge Areas	Lead (at least) 1 Challenge Area activity
<b>Milestone 2</b>	Participate in 5 activities from each Challenge Area	Assist in 3 or more activities across two or more Challenge Areas	Lead 2 or more Challenges Area activities
<b>Milestone 3</b>	Participate in 4 activities from each Challenge Area	Assist in 4 or more activities from at least 2 Challenge Areas	Lead (at least) 4 Challenge Area activities
