

Cub Scout Commissioner Challenge 2021

Do you enjoy using your Outdoor Adventure Skills? Have you got a Special Interest? Well, the Cub Scout Commissioner Challenge this year will let you and your Unit shine.

You can choose to do most of the challenges as a whole Unit or by breaking up into smaller Project Patrols. The SIA challenge will need to be done in Project Patrols.

Here are the Challenges

Community

Plan and run an activity or event that will help your Community. This could be around the environment, talking with other groups in your community or helping at a bigger community event.

Bushcraft

Design and build a shelter that could keep at least two people dry. Send in a photo of the shelter.

Bushwalking

Plan a bushwalk or bike hike for your Unit. You may not get to complete it this year, but you will have a planned hike ready to go when we can get back in the outdoors together. You can have people join you from other Sections or even other Units if you wish. Make sure the hike will be Adventurous, Fun, Challenging and Inclusive.

Camping

Get ready to go camping. Plan a camp that your Unit could go on, don't forget to have a theme for the camp, a delicious menu written up, some imaginative activity ideas and a list of safety checks. Don't worry if your calendar is full this year, you just need to do the planning.

Special Interest Area

Find out what things you like to do that other Cubs in your Unit enjoy too. Set up a Project Patrol with these Cub Scouts and have a brainstorming activity to plan for a Special Interest Area (SIA) activity. This is all about getting the ideas happening – you don't have to complete the activity this year, just capture the ideas, make a plan and tell your Unit all about it. Let's see how excited people get by your ideas!
