PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

Welcome to Winter Gathering!

Eumeralla is a unique and fantastic place; we hope you enjoy your time at WG 2022. We ask that you read the following information carefully as your personal safety is of the utmost importance.

DADS Rules

WG 2022 is operating under the standard Venturers Victoria "DADS Rules". This means none of the following will be tolerated:

- Drug Use (including illicit drugs, misuse of prescription drugs, smoking/vaping)
- Alcohol Use
- Discriminatory Behaviour
- Sexual Activity

Additionally, no energy drinks are to be brought to or consumed on site.

Should any Venturers be found to be breaching these rules, they will be sent home immediately at their own expense, and the rest of the unit risks being sent home as well if found complicit.

Should you find any other Venturers breaching these rules, please report them to your Venturer Leader and/or WG Admin.

Risk Management & Site Safety

WG 2022 is a major event and has a number of important rules for the purposes of managing safety & risk:

1. Fires are only permitted in the provided fire drums. No firewood is to be collected off the ground of the campsite, Units found doing this will be sent home.
2. Generators and driving of vehicles on site (unless specifically approved by WG 2022) is not permitted.
3. Smoking is only permitted for adults, and only in the designated smoking area (this will be advised to Leaders/Rovers at the Leader/Rover briefing). Water has been provided in this location in case of fire, they are to be used solely for that purpose.
4. Any hazards are to be reported to the WG 2022 Risk Manager via the Administration Office.
5. All participants must abide by the Scouts Australia Code of Conduct, Australian & Victorian Laws
6. Unit Leaders are responsible & accountable for conduct of their participants. Participants may have their involvement at WG 2022 terminated for misconduct, inappropriate, or dangerous behaviour, with transport costs fully borne by their unit.
7. WG 2022 is held during a time of cold weather – please bring warm clothes and layer up.
8. Rubbish must be disposed of in the rubbish bins provided
9. Your conduct on social media is reflective on Venturer Scouts & the wider Scouting community, do not post compromising or inappropriate material.

Assistance at WG 2022

If you require any assistance while on site, please visit the Administration Office which is open early each day until late, located at the Troop Hall.

First Aid / Welfare

WG 2022 is supported by a trained first aid team, based at the Environment Centre. Units should take care of minor injuries themselves with their own first aid kits, but for more serious injuries or illness the First Aid Team is available for assistance. If you require urgent medical assistance, let one of the WG 2022 Staff & Team know and they will dispatch them to assist you.

WG 2022 also has a dedicated Welfare team on site to assist with any serious welfare issues beyond what Units can deal with directly. Welfare is also located at the Environment Centre.

Police & Security

The WG event have their own security team, if further support is required from Victoria Police during the weekend, they will be engaged from the local station on a case-by-case basis.

Fire

South-Eastern Australia is one of the most fire prone areas of the world, as a result WG 2022 is supported by the Scouts Victoria Fire & Emergency Management Team. They will respond to any Fire or Emergency based incident on site.

Event Evacuation

WG 2022 is being held during a period of the year that is considered low risk for weather events that would require evacuation of the site. However, WG 2022 has a number of defined triggers to relocate from the site in the event of such an emergency.

If evacuation is determined, you will be notified by WG 2022 via the Public Address (PA) System and asked to convene at the mustering location at which point you will be accounted for by your Unit Leader (or delegate). Please move to the mustering area promptly as time is critical.

If we do evacuate, you will need to ensure you bring the following:

- Water bottle
- Rain Jacket
- Hat
- Money
- Any medication you require
- WG 2022 wristband
- Personal Identification such as Passport, Drivers Licence, or the like

Our muster location is in front of the Troop Hall.

Depending on the risk, the camp will either be fully evacuated or alternatively we will shelter in place based on the risk & intelligence information we receive.

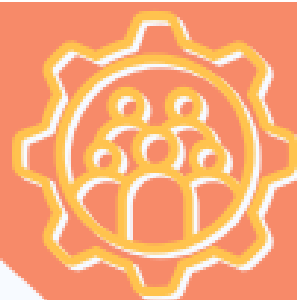
