

Our fit-for-purpose structure for On The Job training




Training Pathway











Verification of On The Job training is now online




The trainee accesses the On The Job training





The trainee completes and submits their checklist







Who signs what?

- The 'Team Leader' with a Gilwell Woggle signs off the Certificate of Proficiency checklists
 - For Youth Program Leaders, the Team Leader is the Group Leader or the Leader in Charge
- The 'Team Leader's Team Leader' with a Wood Badge signs off the Scouting Leadership checklist
 - For most Youth Program Leaders, this will be the District Commissioner, who can delegate as appropriate.

Keep an eye out for 'retrospective' training qualifications going on member records.

E.g. Retrospective COAL-Section

These are the basis of our role pre-requisite options.



For leaders continuing in their roles

- Fully trained leaders continuing in their current role will not be required to retrain
- Leaders with a COAL and no training since 2020 will need to update some On-Demand and On The Job to proceed to Scouting Leadership and the CAAL.
- Leaders without a COAL/COP continue under the current system (basically treated as a new leader)



For leaders transitioning between roles

Rules of thumb that guide transitioning leader pathways:

- On The Jobs (the current or incoming model) no longer have to be repeated between sections, but: Technical Skills and In-Service are no longer accepted instead.
- On-Demand Modules must be completed as a knowledge check (but there are quizzes to help make this quick)
- Basic Practical is accepted for Essentials
- Basic Outdoor Skills (and equivalent) is accepted for Adventure
- Scouting Leadership is more about people management now. If you have a Sectional Wood Badge, you'll need a Scouting Leadership course if you want to transition to Leader of Adults.
