It's time for Victoria's Cub Scouts to sign up to Cuboree.

This is an adventure on an enormous scale, an extraordinary five days of challenges, creativity, new skills, mud, entertainment, fun and friends. (Plus the usual routine of daily life: meals, washing, cleaning up, sleeping.)

Organised by the volunteer leaders of Scouts Victoria, this is the biggest camp any Cub Scout can enjoy, bigger by far than anything they will do with school. The Victorian Cuboree is held every three years at Gilwell Park, one hour east of Melbourne and we hope your family will be part of this incredible experience. This year, Cuboree runs from Monday 25 to Friday 29 September 2023; the second week of the school holidays.

It's a massive learning experience - a growing experience - their biggest step vet towards responsible independence and learning to work and play well with others. Your Cub Scout will be well cared for, well fed, challenged and entertained. Food, transport, accommodation (tents organised by your Group or District, plus blocks of toilets and showers), activities and entertainment, power, welfare, and much more is provided for the event fee of \$400 (Leaders, Venturers, Rovers and Adult Helpers pay a reduced fee.)

How do Cub Scouts cope with five days away from home? In our experience, extremely well. (Often better than their parents are coping at home!)
