1	Australian Scout Award gets approved at the Unit Council.
2	Unit Council delegate emails (preferred) or mails recipients application form to Branch/State Office (Member support/Youth Awards email) and cc'ed to District Commissioner/Leader Scouts or appropriate person at the District level and the Group Leader, or Leader-In-Charge, of the Scout Group.
3	Branch/State Office receives Australian Scout Award Notice of Completion form via email (preferred) or mail.
4	If the youth member is no longer registered in the Scout Section, office to contact Branch/State Scout Commissioner for confirmation on awardee's eligibility.
5	Branch/State Office to add recipient's award to membership record.
6	Branch/State Office to mail the Unit Leader or Scout Leader directly with the youth member's badge.
7	Group to arrange awarding the recipient and advises District/Region of ceremony. The Award should be issued in an important way for the individual. Please refer to the Ceremonies chapter of the Program Handbook for guidance.
8	Branch/State Office puts recipient on roll for the next award presentation.
